



Crossroads multi-farm CSA

Application Deadline: May 15th, 2016!

Crossroads Community Food Network, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, operates the Crossroads Farmers Market and multi-farm CSA on Wednesdays from June 1st through November 18th, on Anne Street at University Blvd. in Takoma Park, MD. All proceeds go directly to cultivating a more inclusive food system in the Takoma/Langley Crossroads.

Share Options

Base share: \$550 (25 weeks, \$22/ week):

Ideal for 2-4 people. Assorted fresh, local fruits, vegetables, and herbs. The Crossroads multi-farm CSA purchases directly from Crossroads Farmers Market farmers. We prioritize naturally grown produce and low/no-spray farming methods. This year the base share CSA will support Tuckey's Mountain Grown Produce (Integrated Pest Management - IPM) and Owl's Nest Farm (Certified Naturally Grown).

Add-ons:

In addition to the base share, Crossroads CSA customers can choose biweekly (every other week) or monthly (every first Wednesday of the month) add-on items at additional costs. This year CSA add-ons will support Smith Meadows Kitchen, Alcoba Coffee, and Suttler Post Farm. ****You may choose more than one option, and/or multiples of items (such as 3 pastas, 2 dozen eggs, 2 bags of coffee, etc.).** Write in the quantity and calculate your costs below. Please note that certain add-on items require a minimum number of signups. If we do not reach this minimum, we will let you know that this add-on item will not be available as part of the CSA.

Payment:

Since many add-on items are contingent on a minimum number of signups, we are asking our members to **send a down payment of \$275:** equal to half a base share. Once CSA signups are complete in May, we will ask members to send a check for the remaining balance to complete their membership payment = **\$275 + any seasonal add-on costs**. At this time, we are only able to accept checks for CSA payments.

***Please include a check for \$275 as a down payment with your application. You will be asked to send the remaining balance when the CSA coordinator confirms add-on availability and cost. Please mail the check and application to:**
